PLEASE HAVE EVERYTHING READY TO GO ON THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS

Brushes

Assortment of bristle brushes (I suggest large, medium and small in Flats and Filberts)

Canvas

Four stretched canvas or canvas mounted on board or gessoed wood panel (sizes can range from 8x10, 9x12 to 11x14) depending on your preference. If you like to paint large bring all 11x14. If you like to paint smaller bring all 8x10 or you may want to bring different sizes (two 8x10, one 9x12, one 11x14)

Paints

I recommend a minimal palette of a warm and cool version of the three primaries plus white (with maybe a few extras) Student grade is cheaper but contains less pigment so the colors are chalky. If you can, spend the extra money for professional grade paints. I use Winsor & Newton, Gamblin, and Holbein and there are many other good options.

- Gamblin Cadmium Yellow Deep
- Gamblin Yellow Ochre
- Winsor & Newton Alizarin Crimson
- Gamblin Cadmium Red Light

- Williamsburg Ultramarine Blue
- Gamblin Cobalt Blue
- Rembrandt Transparent Red Oxide
- Winsor & Newton Titanium White

Optional Colors: Cadmium Orange, Olive Green (Holbein), Lemon Yellow
